The Explanatory Statement pursuant to the provisions of Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act') read with Section 110 of the Act and Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 ('Rules'), each as amended, setting out the material facts relating to the aforesaid Resolution and the reasons thereof is annexed hereto and forms part of this Notice.
2. In terms of the MCA Circulars, the Company is sending this Notice ONLY through electronic form to those Members whose names appear in the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as received by the Company from the Depositories/Purva Shareregistry India Private Limited, the Company's Registrar and Transfer Agent ('RTA'), as on **Friday, February 7, 2025 ('Cut-Off Date')** and whose e-mail addresses are registered with the Company/RTA/Depositories/Depository Participants and who will register their e-mail address in accordance with the process outlined in this Notice. 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EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102(1) AND 110 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013.

ITEM NO. 1 APPOINTMENT OF STATUTORY AUDITOR TO FILL CASUAL VACANCY:

The following Statement(s) sets out all material facts relating to Resolution mentioned in the accompanying Notice.

M/s. PPN and Company, Chartered Accountants (Firm Reg. No. 013623S), were appointed as the Statutory Auditors of the Company in 21st Annual General Meeting of the Company held on September 22, 2023 and was entitled to hold office upto the conclusion of 25th Annual General Meeting of the Company. However, M/s. PPN and Company, Chartered Accountants vide their letter dated January 30, 2025, have tendered their resignation as the Statutory Auditor of the Company due to Pre-occupation in some other assignments. This has resulted into a casual vacancy in the office of Statutory Auditors of their Company as envisaged by Section 139(8) of the Companies Act, 2013. Further, pursuant the provisions of Section 139 (8) of the Companies Act, 2013, Casual vacancy caused by the resignation of auditor shall also be approved by the shareholders in General Meeting within three months from the date of appointment by the Board of Directors of the Company.

Accordingly, based on the recommendations of the Audit Committee, the Board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on February 5, 2025 appointed M/s. Krishaan & Co., Chartered Accountants, (Firm Registration Number: 001453S), as the Statutory Auditors of the Company to fill the casual vacancy caused due to the resignation of M/s. PPN and Company and shall hold office of the Statutory Auditors until the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting to be held during the year 2025 and they shall conduct the Statutory Audit for the financial year ending on March 31, 2025. M/s. Krishaan & Co., Chartered Accountants, (Firm Registration Number: 001453S), have given their consent for being appointed as Statutory Auditors of the Company along with a confirmation that, their appointment, if made by the members, would be within the limits prescribed under the Companies Act, 2013 and shall satisfy the criteria as provided under Section 141 of the Companies Act, 2013.
